INCUMBENT

1. Voted against SB 102 (2012) closed a loophole for abortionists who refused to meet with women in person before an abortion was performed. It required a face-to-face meeting between the abortionist and woman. Voted against SB 103 (2012) Required abortionists to provide an ultrasound, show the picture and give a detailed explanation to the woman seeking an abortion. She consistently votes pro-abortion.

2 & 3. Voted for HB 290 (2010) which would have increased Kentucky's debt by approximately \$1 billion and added \$270 million in new taxes on businesses. Co-sponsored HB 318 (2011) which would have increase taxes by \$1 billion for the biennium.

4. Voted for HB 396 (2008) which forced pre-teen girls to be vaccinated for HPV before they could enter public school. It was an untested drug on this age group.

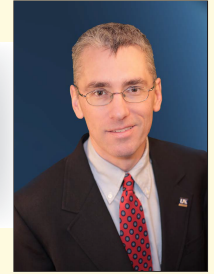
5. Voted against SB 112 (2008) and SB 152 (2007) both of which upheld the intent of the 2004 marriage amendment by prohibiting any state agency from conferring benefits to unmarried heterosexual or homosexual couples.
