3. Voted against HB 215 (2011) late-term abortion ban after baby is 20 weeks in utero. Voted against HB 243 (2011) which would have prohibited out-of-state minors from getting an abortion without parental consent. Has voted for ultrasound legislation but his mixed record is a reflection of his unwillingness to consistently vote for the sanctity of life at the times when it is most needed.
